



Grand Lake Improvement District Update

Financial Report:

- Assets:
 - Balance as of 5/18/2016 = \$32,624.52
 - Expected 1st half tax receipts = \$14,500.00
- Upcoming Expenses:
 - Second payment for ILID
 - Curley Leaf Treatment
 - Sauk River Water Quality Testing
 - E-Coli Testing
- 2016 Lake Improvement Initiatives:
 - ILID: Access Video Monitoring System
 - Video Tapes all boats entering and leaving Grand Lake
 - Audio message that cycles every 4 minutes based on movement.
 - Total Cost including I-Cloud monitoring = \$9,195.00
 - Grant from Stearns County = \$4,273.75
 - Board Members will also be monitoring Video's to gain knowledge on weekday activities.
 - Weekend and Holiday Boat Inspection Program:
 - 100% funding from Stearns County for 248 Hours of inspection at a cost of \$4216.00
 - Inspection for all boats launching and leaving access from 7AM to 3 PM on all weekends and holidays. (Subject to change)
 - Zebra Mussel Detection Plates
 - 10 detection plates have been placed around the lake to hopefully not detect the presence of Zebra Mussels.
 - Current activity shows a lot of Chinese Snail activity.
 - Continuation of Curly-leaf Chemical Treatment
 - Treatment of 33 acres at 5 different sites
 - Grant from DNR of \$3025 to cover 50% of costs.
 - Continuation of Water Quality Testing of Grand Lake, Ploof's Creek and Johannes Creek.

 - Stearns County AIS Committee
 - Stearns County Coalition of Lake Associations
